El Paso Museum of Art (US)

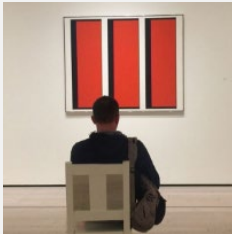

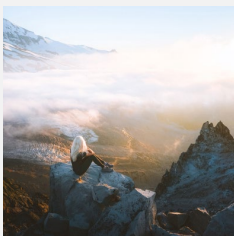
ASHTHORP.ART
